Assessment and Treatment Services:

We provide up to three free EAP sessions for crisis stabilization, referral or brief counseling. We deal with a full range of mental health and adjustment issues and also provide referrals for legal, financial or other types of assistance.

Other than mandatory supervisor referrals, for which some information is provided back to the employer in terms of attendance and follow up, information is confidential.

Our neuropsychologists are skilled at assessing a variety of childhood, adolescent, adult and senior difficulties with memory, learning, and attention. Again, please note that IQ and learning disability testing is not covered by most insurance plans.
